<i>Equipment Required</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Thin nozzle applicator bottle – targeted application • Clean absorbent cloths • Equipment and materials for extraction cleaning after treatment
<i>Use Instructions</i>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Gently scrape/vacuum any excess/loose soiling from the carpet. 2. Apply a small amount of product to a clean cloth or directly to the stained area. Allow to dwell for 30-60 seconds. 3. Gently blot the stained area with a clean absorbent cloth turning frequently. 4. Repeat as necessary taking care not to over-soak the fabric. 5. Remove traces of solvent. Rinse extract with CFT Fibre and Fabric Rinse this will also control browning.
<i>Hints & Tips</i>	<p><i>This treatment is always best conducted prior to extraction cleaning.</i></p> <p><i>Always work from the outside of the stain inwards to prevent spreading the stain.</i></p> <p><i>Always blot. Do not be tempted to rub the stain as this can damage the fibres.</i></p>
<i>Precautions</i>	<p>Use all PPE advised in MSDS and COSHH Assessment</p> <p>Test on an inconspicuous area using a clean cloth. Look for signs of dye transfer.</p> <p>Note some flooring adhesives (latex, acrylic/bitumen) soften in the presence of solvents. Exercise caution to prevent over-soaking through to the base material.</p>
