<i>Application</i>	Non-Caustic Standard Vehicle Wash
<i>Features & Benefits</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Caustic Free – safer to use • Excellent performance on all vehicle types • Biodegradable formulation • Versatile – manual or pressure washer use
<i>Dilution</i>	Light Soiling: 1% (100:1) Medium Soiling 2% (50:1) Heavy Soiling 3% (30:1)
<i>Equipment Required</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pressure washer • Suitable dilution vessel • Bucket/Mop • Water supply
<i>Use Instructions</i>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Fleet Clean NC may be used hot or cold via a pressure washer. For best results use hot. 2. Suitable dilutions are normally established by experience. See guidance above. 3. Apply chemical to the surface of the vehicle at low or high, pressure working from the <u>bottom of the vehicle upward</u> to avoid cleaning-streaks. 4. In hot weather cool paintwork with water <u>before</u> applying chemical. <u>Do not</u> allow the chemical to dry on the surface. 5. Rinse with a bucket, hose or pressure washer <u>from the top of the vehicle rinsing downwards</u> evenly and methodically.
<i>Hints & Tips</i>	<p><i>For the very best results, use warm water (<60°C at machine)</i></p> <p><i>When applying chemical, to avoid cleaning-streaks, always work from <u>bottom to top</u> of vehicle.</i></p>
<i>Precautions</i>	<p><u>Always</u> observe precautions set out in the material safety data sheet.</p> <p>For fresh or damaged paint/livery check compatibility on an inconspicuous area first.</p>
