<b><i>User Instructions</i></b>	<p><b>Flushing Guns and Spray Equipment</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Simply draw Gunclean through the spray equipment and allowing paint and resin deposits to be carried away. This should not be done in an enclosed space. Check adequate ventilation.</li> <li>2. Then flush water and allow to drain.</li> </ol> <p><b>Soaking and Softening</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Gunclean can be used in a soak tank to free up and release blocked jets and gun parts.</li> <li>2. Keep soak tank covered.</li> </ol>
<b><i>Hints &amp; Tips</i></b>	<p><i>Do not mix with other solvents</i></p> <p><i>Keep solvent baths covered.</i></p>
